Tips & Tricks for Use

In principle, your own hairband will last for years, especially if handled with care. Here are some tips & tricks to extend its lifetime.

Brushing



Your hair is fixed tightly to the hairband, but we advise you to brush and comb it gently, as otherwise the hair may come loose. If you get knots in your hair, it is best to remove them with your fingers and some water. Afterwards, when your hair is knot-free and smooth, use the tip of a soft brush to gently brush down strokes through the hair. Please refer to our video for further guidance.

Waves or Curls

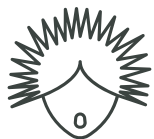


If your hair naturally has curls or is wavy, you can maintain this look by scrunching your hair with your hands. We often achieve good results with water. Be careful with using gel, mousse, or curling products. The hair quickly becomes saturated and will become greasy, and you will need to wash it sooner. So, start with water and (only if required) a very small amount of non-greasy styling product.



Blow-drying/Styling

You can blow-dry your hair as usual. You can also gently style your hair with a straightening or curling iron.



Static

If the hair of your Toupim own-hairband becomes static, apply some water to your fingertips and smooth them over your hair.



How does the hair behave?

Your hair behaves pretty much the same as it did before you cut it. If your hair used to tangle easily, it might still do so. We have a few additional tips for that. In that case, please contact us.

Washing Instructions



You only need to wash your Toupim own-hairband when necessary. It is usually sufficient to wash the hair about once every 2 or 3 months because your hair no longer gets greasy from your scalp. You also don't sleep wearing the hairband. If necessary, you can remove your own hairband and hold it (by the headband) over a wash basin. This way you can wash the hair (just the hair, not the fabric of the headband) with shampoo and rinse it clear with water.

You can also choose to wash the fabric of the headband with regular soap or detergent. In this case, you hold the hair and only wash the fabric.

Storage



It is best not to fold your Toupim own-hairband but to lay it flat on a table and give it some room. You can also choose to put it in a spacious plastic bag and hang the bag on a coat rack or the back of a chair. The hairband doesn't have a specific shape, so it doesn't need to be put on a stand or a mannequin head.



What if the elastic becomes loose?

We have a fix in case the hairband becomes looser over time. Please watch the video to show you how to do this. For this, you will need the Toupim elastic that was provided in the package which came with your own hairband. So please keep this safe.

What do I do if I no longer need my Toupim own-hairband?

If you no longer use your own hairband, and it is still in reasonable condition, we would love to receive it back. We will refurbish it and make someone else happy with it. As a thank you for this gesture, we will give you €50 in return. Please contact us if you want to return your own hairband.
